70 new jobs created , many women employed

Since December 2013, Harvesting 4 Haiti (H4H) has given financial and business assistance to the Haitian agricultural organization, Planting for Hope and Future (PHF) in order to help them become self-sustaining. In less than two years, H4H has witnessed France Dorcel Ady’s God-given dream of helping Haitians through an agriculture program, take shape. This dream included bringing new ideas, and technology to Haiti, as well as wanting to increase the job market in a land with 85% unemployment. It is now an established program with:

1. Four farms, 2. Ten areas of farmland developed, 3. 11,000 plantain planted, 4. Multiple harvests of multiple crops, 5. Two different methods of irrigation used, 6. Has employed many women, 7. Created 70 jobs, 8. Provided education to local farmers - doubling their crop production, 9. Started negotiations with two Haitian universities to start a partnership and help with education of their students, 10. Talked with HeloHaiti (below) to produce a garden on their property with vocational education provided for their children.

PHF is on target to become self-sustaining in three years.


Spreading the Word Across Country
